## Certificate delivery

The OSA Certificate of Online Safety is delivered online and can be completed in lessons or independently as home learning. It provides full access to all learning materials required to complete the course, including high quality animated videos, presentations and summary documents.

All assessment is carried out online, with pupils able to progress at their own pace by taking tests when they feel ready.

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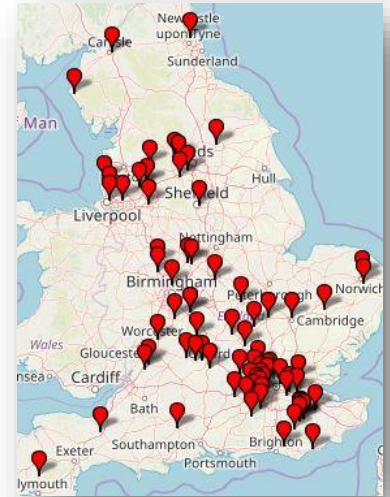

## How to subscribe
